

### **Scope and Declaration of Intent**

EXWOLD TECHNOLOGY LTD. has secured registration as a firm of Assessed Capability under the requirements of ISO 14001: 2004 for the Blending, Granulation, Drying, Size Reduction, Packaging and Storage of Solid and Liquid Chemicals and Industrial Products.

The company is committed to the protection of the environment through the control, monitoring and improvement of its environmental performance.

Accordingly, this policy statement has been formulated in keeping with the principles as laid out in the international standard ISO 14001:2004 and the company EMS (Environmental Management System). The company will integrate operations of environmental significance with the high standards of quality and social responsibility in place and with their ISO9001 accredited QMS (Quality Management System).

### **Commitment to Legal Compliance**

The company is committed to meeting the requirements of current and future environmental legislation as a minimum standard of performance. This includes matters related to waste disposal, effluent discharge and emissions to air including regulations associated with road transport vehicles, energy consumption and water usage and all permissions granted by statutory authorities

### **Commitment to Continual Improvement**

The company has established its baseline environmental performance level by carrying out a review of all activities that may have impact upon the environment in its widest sense. Areas of generally identified good practice will be monitored for performance levels and these will be maintained or improved as required. Activities identified as capable of improvement will be included in a programme that aims to reduce the environmental burden associated with provision of the company's services. As new wider environmental issues are established, the company will also integrate such considerations into this policy and the EMS.

### **Commitment to Training**

In keeping with the company's commitment to development of staff, the company undertake to include general awareness raising of environmental issues and to carry out training regarding specific aspects of activities identified as having significant impact upon the environment.

### **Commitment to Communication**

The company will ensure that all employees are made aware of the environmental policy and of the company's performance levels as monitored and recorded from time to time. In addition, the company will endeavour to disseminate good environmental practice to suppliers of goods and services as appropriate, encouraging them to embrace best practice and make available reasonable records of performance and of policy implementation to genuinely interested parties within limits of confidentiality.

### **Commitment to Objectives**

The company has established the following objectives with a view to maintaining or improving environmental performance:

- Maintain and update a register of statutory requirements.
- Repair, refurbish, re-use or recycle products and materials where practicable and environmentally sensible, considering disposal as a last resort.
- Purchase products with a recycled content where performance levels and economics do not detract from the quality of service associated with the company.
- Prefer products that have the smallest environmental impact in terms of potential pollution or global warming etc.
- Encourage and assist employees and suppliers to minimise their consumption of natural resources including raw materials, fuels and energy and to thereby minimise the production of wastes.
